Frequently Asked Questions

What are the size and wieght specifications for First Class Mail.

Postcard

At least 3-1/2 inches high x 5 inches long x 0.007 inch thick. No more than 4-1/4 inches high x 6 inches long x 0.016 inches thick.

Letter

At least 3-1/2 inches high x 5 inches long x 0.007 inch thick. No more than 6 1/8 inches high x 11.5 inches long x 0.25 inches thick.

Flat

Mail piece must have one dimension that is greater than 6-1/8 inches high OR 11-½ inches long (the side parallel to the address as read) OR ¼ inch thick. Be no more than 12 inches high x 15 inches long x ¾ inch thick. Weigh no more than 13 ounces.

Standard Mail (Non Profit Mail)

There is no postcard rate for standard or non profit mail, so all postcards are mailed at the letter rate.

Mail pieces must have an aspect ratio (length divided by height) of between 1.3 and 2.5 to qualify for automation rates.

What class of service should I choose for my mailing?

Postage discounts are available for presorted mail; below is an overview of discounts and estimated delivery timelines.

First Class Mail

Priority service ahead of all other types of mail. Local delivery is generally 1-2 days with national delivery between 3-5 days.

Presort First Class Mail

Priority service at a 20% savings over First Class Mail. Must have at least 500 identical pieces, be NCOA compliant, presorted and meet all other specifications.

Presort Standard Mail

Non-priority service at a 40% savings over First Class Mail. Must have at least 200 identical pieces, be NCOA compliant, presorted and meet all other specifications. Local delivery can be 1 - 4 days, national delivery could range from 4 days to 3 weeks.

Non Profit Ma

This is standard mail delivery for qualified non profit organizations. Postage discounts can be as deep as 70% over First Class Mail with typically the same delivery times as Presort Standard Mail.

What are Automation rates?

Automated rates are for mail pieces that comply with postal regulations in both mail piece design and Intelligent Mail Barcode qualification. Mailings that do not comply must be sent at the higher non automated machinable or non-machinable rate.
